I am writing to inform Liverpool City Region Academy Trust that a decision has been made on the future of Emslie Morgan Academy, Wirral.

Following careful consideration of the responses received during the listening period, which concluded on 17 May 2019, the Department has made a decision to close the school, at the end of the 2018/19 academic year. This closure is by mutual agreement with the Trust.

My team, led by Debbie Dempsey (Deborah.Dempsey@education.gov.uk) will continue to work with the Trust to enable a smooth closure process, working alongside the ESFA, who are responsible for the termination of the Supplemental Funding Agreement for an August 2019 closure of the school.

I am grateful for your ongoing support to those staff and pupils who will remain at the school until closure.
