Decision on the future of Emslie Morgan Academy

The Trust Board responsible for Emslie Morgan Academy has today announced that the school is to close on 31 August 2019.

Emslie Morgan Academy, based in Leasowe, currently educates 68 students between the ages of 11 and 16.

This decision was taken by the Department for Education, with the agreement of the Liverpool City Region Academy Trust Board, following the consideration of responses received during the listening period from 17 April to 17 May 2019.

Over the remaining weeks of this Summer term, the Trust and the School will work closely with Wirral Local Authority as they make appropriate and timely arrangements for pupils in Years 7 to 10 to continue their education at other providers from September.

Staff who are employed at the school have been notified of the decision to close the school and support will be made available to them during this difficult time to secure further employment.
